- Joanna (Treasurer): Monthly report—May 1, 2021 Revenue: \$3657.33 Expenditures: \$2073.04 Net Revenue: \$914.29

(Increase in rent at the OAsis starting on July 1, 2021 from approximately \$1600/mo to \$2300/mo). 12 months of abstinence with 6 months of maintenance by your own definition.

Lease Update: Discussions with Management Company. OAsis is still closed, but we still have a lease. The rent was reduced from \$2378 down to \$1600 for 9 months, now will go back to \$2378. Our lease expires January 2022. We have potential to extend for one more year if landlord is in agreement and we are in agreement. Beth spoke to Mgt. attorney. Are they going to allow us to stay? Can we renegotiate? Our needs may be changing. We may want to go to a smaller location. We don't want to wait until 3 months before the lease expires to figure this out. Management attorney will come back with some options for us because we have been good tenants. Also, we are appreciative for lowering the rent for 9 months.

When are we going to open? Visiting this on a monthly basis. Lots to take into consideration—safety, monitoring, liability, space.

- 15. Jessica H. WSBC Delegate/Ginger/Delegate: WSBC was in April virtually. Some notes from Ginger: Tools of Recovery was updated—rewrote literature tool description.

New "Plan of Eating"—combined two previously pamphlets—Dignity of Choice and a Plan of Eating. 4 sample plans and then appendix B – what is a serving size? What to do on long days/irregular hours? Reaching the IBW (Ideal Body Weight). Definition of abstinence.

"Voices of Recovery"—updated quotations from 12 and 12. Discussion about Pronouns—"He" with regards to God.

Delegates are assigned to a committee—Ginger was on Public Info and Professional Outreach. There is a Trustee on each committee. 38 delegates representing 7 countries. Plan is for a 24/7 OA welcome room—virtual room for members, newcomers, those searching for a solution—Goal for 2021. Second goal—manuals—combining Public Info and Professional Outreach.

Beth explained—what World Service is—the World Service Business Conference is a group of delegates from around the world doing the OA business. 10 geographic regions and 1 virtual region. It is a huge service and commitment. We can have more delegates from San Diego if you are interested in doing this type of service.
