REPORTS

<u>Chair, Kathy H.</u> – It is important that meetings set aside time for IG Reps to read the Highlights of the monthly IG meeting at their meetings. If that is not happening, meetings should schedule a business meeting to add reading of the Highlights to the meeting format.

<u>Treasurer, Maureen C.</u> – June 2023 financial report (summary): Revenue = \$1,671.49; Expenses = \$566.94. Received \$1,105.85 more than paid out.

- We are sending donations to World Service and Region 2, totaling \$1,000, as allocated by our annual budget.
- The question was raised as to the maximum donation that can be accepted from an individual member: WSO sets its maximum at \$7,500, but that is for WSO only. Each Intergroup sets its own maximum. SD Intergroup has not set a maximum.

<u>Webmaster, Ellen L</u> – Ellen reminded IG reps that we have a "Token program" whereby volunteers will mail tokens to people at Zoom meetings.

 IG Reps and Board members unanimously voted to amend our Bylaws to delete Webmaster from the list of Board members and make it a volunteer non-Board position with no termination dates.
