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SCREEN SHARING

The screen shots in this class are for computers – PC or Mac, desktop or laptop. Screen sharing on mobile devices – tablets and phones – vary greatly.

NOTES

- Entire desktop or tablet/phone screen
- One or more specific apps
- A portion of your screen
- Content from a second camera
- Whiteboard
- A locally stored video
- Audio played from a device

WHAT YOU CAN SHARE

Screen sharing can be set to hosts and co-hosts ONLY either by default by the account holder or during a meeting under the Security button.

The safest way is to make a person who needs to share a co-host for that purpose.

ENABLE SCREEN SHARING

Limit screen sharing to hosts and co-hosts. ROOM SETTINGS You cannot modify the advanced sharing options as these settings are locked by your admin. How many participants can share at the same time? One participants can share at time Multiple participants can share simultaneously (dual monitors recommended) Who can share? One host only All Participants Who can start sharing when someone else is sharing? One host only All Participants

FIRST: Start up the program and get ready to show:

Website in your browser

PDF in Adobe Acrobat

Text Document in Word, Google Docs, etc.

You can open multiple pages / tabs within the app.

Practice switching among open apps / windows.

PREPARE TO SHARE


The first time you go to share your screen you will need to give Zoom permission.


NOTE FOR MAC USERS

1. Click "Share Screen."



- 2. Select the program to share.
- 3. Click "Share."

3 SIMPLE STEPS



- Switch to your browser and go to a web page or open a document on your computer.
- 2. Optimize it for sharing and leave it open.
- 3. Switch back to Zoom. Click "Share Screen."
- 4. Select the program (browser if web page).
- 5. Click SHARE

YOUR TURN

You see a notification – "Participants can now see..."

TIPS

Meeting controls move into a menu that you can drag around. Controls will depend on what features are enabled.

Green: "You are screen sharing"

Red: "Stop Share."

TIPS

Queue it up – Be prepared!


Just show the content. Use presenter view, resize windows, etc.


Don't open up screen sharing to all. Make a participant a cohost.

1. View options: Side-by-side mode

- Click and drag the separator to adjust the size of each view.
