- 1. Receive Speaker Release email.
- 2. Enter speaker data on the internal database.
- 3. Download the podcast from your Zoom account.
- 4. Edit, cutting out extraneous parts, people's names, and traditions violations using audio editing software such as Audacity.
- 5. Upload to podcast provider LibSyn.
- 6. Publish to our Facebook page from within LibSyn
- 7. Send the URL to Ellen to publish on the website.
- 8. Send a thank you note with a link to the speaker.
