4.	has has volunteered to read the <b>OA Preamble</b> .
5.	has volunteered to read <b>The Twelve Steps</b> .

6.	(Only the first Saturday of each month)has volunteered to read <b>The Twelve Traditions</b> .
7.	<b>Leader reads: TOOLS</b> - Abstinence is the action of refraining from compulsive eating. Many of us have found that we cannot abstain unless we use some or all of OA's 9 tools of recovery. They are: a plan of eating, sponsorship, meetings, telephone, writing, literature, anonymity, service and a plan of action.
8.	<b>Leader reads: SPONSORSHIP</b> is one of our keys to success. Sponsors are OA members committed to abstinence and to living the 12 Steps & 12 Traditions to the best of their ability. Sponsors share their program up to the level of their experience, and they strengthen their recovery by offering this service to others. To find a sponsor, look for someone who has what you want and ask how he or she is achieving it.
9.	Are there any <b>OA announcements or reports</b> ?
10.	<b>TOKENS / SLOGANS:</b> At this meeting we give out tokens, program sayings or slogans to celebrate periods of abstinence. We also give out commitment sayings or slogans to anyone who wishes to publicly state their intention to recover.
	If you take a token or saying and would like to share, please limit your sharing to one minute. I'll now turn the meeting over to our Token / Slogan Volunteer
11.	This meeting format is a meditation, writing, and sharing meeting. We use the <b>Voices of Recovery</b> reading as a suggestion for our meditation.
12.	has volunteered to read today's reading from the <b>Voices of Recovery</b> .
13.	has volunteered to be our <b>Timer</b> for our meditation, writing, and sharing.
14.	Will everyone please mute themselves now during our <b>Five Minute Meditation?</b>

- 15. **Writing:** It is now time to get **3 Questions** from the group to write on. The questions should pertain to recovery and compulsive eating. Who has a question?
- 16. Will everyone please mute themselves during our writing on these questions for 8 minutes? (Our Timer will advise us when 6 minutes has passed and when the remaining 2 minutes have passed.)
- 17. **SHARING:** It is now time to share on our writing. To give all a chance to share, please limit your sharing to **2 (+1) minutes** and focus your sharing on recovery. Our Timer will advise us when 2 minutes has passed and then when the remaining 1 minute has passed.
